

Check Homework Ask a few students to read out their findings from their surveys and have a vote on whose findings were the same.

Discussion

Write this new expression on the board and ask students to copy it.

"You can't have your cake and eat it too."

Explain the new word (cake). Elicit what the expression means. Ask students for another instance when they'd use the expression. (unrelated to the cake - you can't buy everything you want and still have the money / you can't fight with your friends and still expect them to be

your friends).

Discussion Introduce the new vocabulary items. Show the picture of the cake with the

> candles, and introduce the two new colors (pink & green), review the colors already learned (black, brown, red & white). Ask students what

colors they like/hate.

Introduce the two new numbers (13, 14).

Introduce the word **inside** as the opposite of **outside**.

Introduce something (could be related to sometimes), mistake and everybody (opposite of nobody). Point out that both are considered

singular, like he/she/it.

Movie Watch the movie.

**Practice** Students work on specified features from this unit at the teacher's

discretion. Allot 15 minutes for this activity.

Homework Find at least 15 hidden words. Can you find any of their opposites?
