ROUNDTABLE

Roundtable is a good cooperative structure and interactive activity to practice vocabulary, grammar, or even content. Students pass a paper around, adding an item according to the criteria you designate. It is similar to Roundrobin, which is an oral chain activity.

Procedure:

- 1. Divide the class into rows or groups. Prepare a sheet of paper for each group with the target language or question on top.
- 2. The teams use the cooperative structure Roundtable to substitute words or phrases for the underlined word, or to add words or phrases to a list.
- 3. Roundtable is similar to Roundrobin. In Roundtable, each student says a response, writes it on the page, and passes it on. You may want to brainstorm possible substitutions first.
